

We are frequently asked how a logo can be uploaded and published as part of the Matterport Space. Unfortunately, at this time, it's not possible. However, as you may have seen online, there are those finding alternative ways to make it look possible. While we cannot support code and how one can go about troubleshooting this workaround if it doesn't look quite right, we do want to help in any way we can and, at least, set you on the right path - or at least one possible path to this workaround.

In this example, the logo is positioned in the top, right corner of the iframe containing the Space, which is centered on the page. You can tweak the code as you wish, using the guide below, to change the positioning - and depending on the image size of your logo, you may have to.

Copy the code below and paste it in your site where you would like to position your Space.

Use the guide below to help adjust the code example to best suit your needs.

Orange - This is the alignment attribute for the outermost container and will determine whether the Space is centered or justified either right or left depending on what you choose. The options for this attribute are:

- center
- right
- left

Red - This is the width and height attributes for the container nested within the outermost container and will determine the width and height of your Space on the webpage. The values you see here are the same as those in the embed code for the Space in your account. You can change these values to just about anything you want, but keep in mind many visitors are viewing your site on a mobile device, which has very low resolution compared to most desktop machines.

Pink - This determines the distance in pixels your logo will be from the top and right side of your Space. You can choose to increase these values to give the logo a little more cushion from the edges of the Space.

Purple - This is the direct link to your logo. In this case, the link is relative to the HTML document's location.

Blue - Insert here the branded link to your Space. Since the Space is embedded on a webpage, you should use the branded link and not, for example, the MLS compliant or VR link.

Green - Optional are the URL parameters. You can customize your visitors' viewing experience by adding one or more parameters to the end of your Space link.
